About the Reno Gem & Mineral Society

Founded in 1965 through the merger of two long-standing regional societies, the Reno Gem & Mineral Society is a nonprofit organization dedicated to education, lapidary arts, earth sciences, and community.



Our History

The Reno Gem & Mineral Society has a long and meaningful history rooted in community, education, and a shared love of gems, minerals, and lapidary arts.

Our story began in the spring of 1950 with the formation of the Washoe Gem & Mineral Society. In 1954, the Washoe Society affiliated with the California Federation of Mineralogical Societies (CFMS), and by then membership had grown to 104 individuals.

In 1955, twelve members formed the Pyramid Gem & Mineral Society, which joined CFMS in 1958. In the years that followed, the Washoe, Pyramid, and Fallon Lahontan Gem & Mineral Societies hosted annual gem and mineral shows throughout the region, laying the foundation for what would become Jackpot of Gems® Show.

In August 1965, members of the Washoe and Pyramid Societies voted to merge and form the Reno Gem & Mineral Society. The first meeting of the newly combined Society was held on December 1, 1965, and in 1966, the first Jackpot of Gems® Show was held, with Len Vance serving as Show Chairman.

In 1976, after years of meetings and classes in members' homes, garages, and basements, the Society moved to its current home at 480 S. Rock Boulevard, where it continues to foster education, creativity, and community today.

The Reno Gem and Mineral Society, Inc. (RGMS) is a 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation, organized for the purpose of educating, creating, developing, and encouraging interest in earth sciences, as well as gem and mineral hobbies. These include classes, field trips, monthly meetings, guest speakers, use of equipment, social events, newsletters, and best of all, friendships.

The mission of the Reno Gem and Mineral Society is to create, develop, and encourage interest in the Earth Sciences and to locate and identify various materials through field trips.

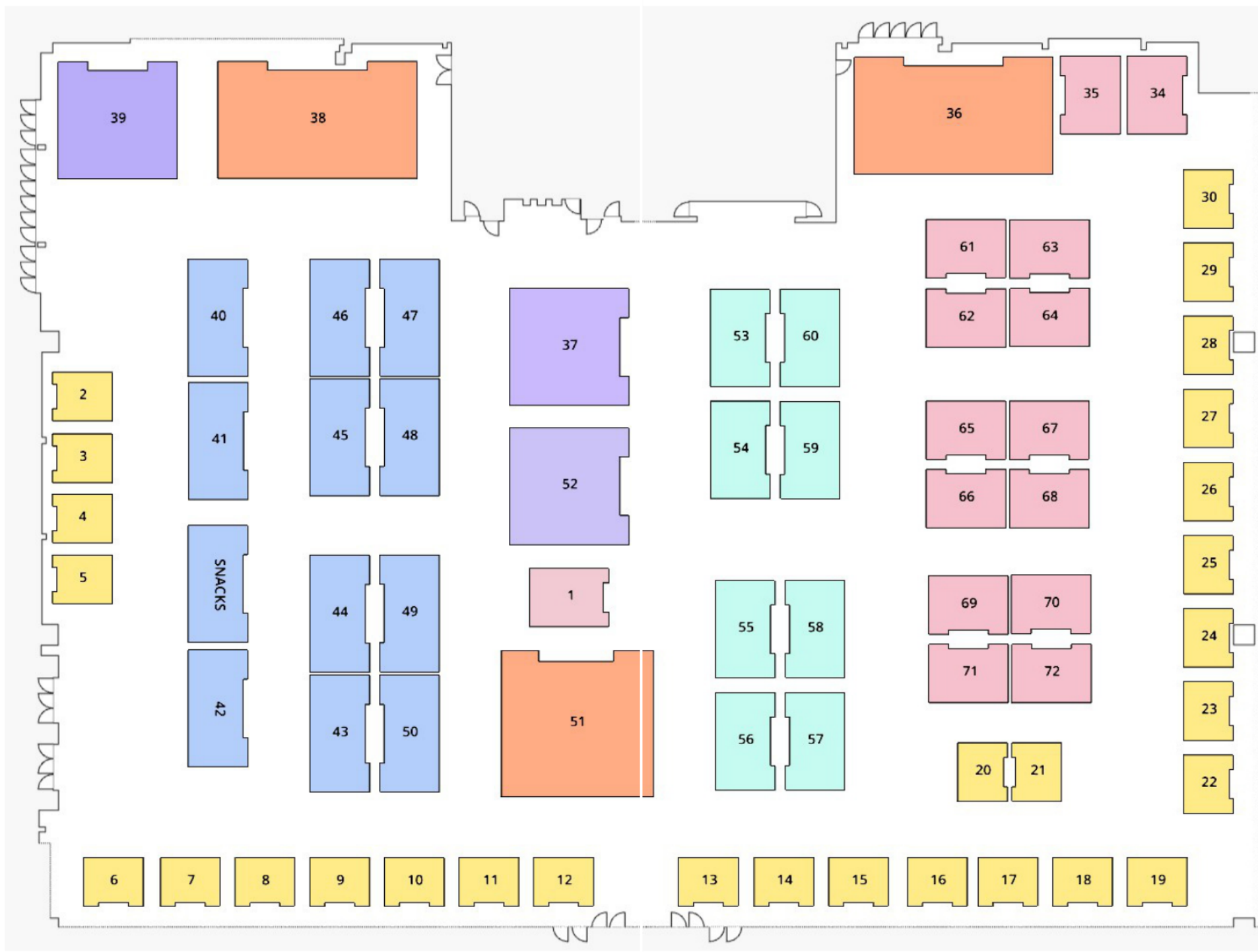
